

Berlin [Speed Bump]

Difficulty ★☆☆☆

Having arrived last in the previous leg, your team was saved from elimination and must now perform a Speed Bump.

In this task, your team must decipher the answers in each other's drawings, here at the East Side Gallery, the longest surviving section of the Berlin Wall which also features many graffiti art pieces.

How will your team clear this Speed Bump?

(To perform this task, sign up for a 15-minute team video-call session by messaging one of the Hunt HQ members on Discord. We recommend that 3–4 members of your team be present for this task.)

This is a HQ interaction event puzzle that can only be experienced during the hunt.

Welcome to the East Side Gallery, the longest surviving section of the Berlin Wall. This section is also famous for the many graffiti art pieces on display.

Having arrived last in the previous leg, your team was saved from elimination and must now perform a Speed Bump here.

In this Speed Bump, one team member must use drawings to transmit 10 pieces of information which the remaining team members need to decipher them and guess the answers correctly.

The team first designates one member as a drawer who is privately given the following list of answers:

BUS
WEEK
8
NAME
SUPPER
JOB
WORDS
SAMURAI
STAND
MINUTE

The other team members will then guess the answers in turn based only on what is being drawn. Teams can skip answers, and have to correctly guess at least 7 out of the 10 answers within 10 minutes to finish this task.

After finishing the task, teams will need to figure out the puzzle answer using the list of answers they have just guessed.

Great job! You now have all the information you need to finish the Speed Bump, the designated drawer should share the list of answers with the team. You can submit your final answer at the puzzle page. But be quick, otherwise you might come in last again!
